1. It must be posted in your office
2. It must be on your consent form.
3. They must specifically state not to bill Medicare on a specific form called; "Restriction of Consent to Use and Disclosure of Protective Health Information." If you have them print, sign and date this form, to my understanding we as chiropractors can treat medicare patients legally without billing or involving Medicare.
